You may have no solid foods to eat, and no milk to drink after midnight the night before surgery. You may however, have water, apple juice, tea, black coffee, or any clear, non-carbonated beverage, from midnight up until three hours before the time of surgery. **Medication Instructions** 1. Medications that **should** be taken the morning of surgery with a small sip of water include: 2. Medicines that should **not** be taken include: *Bring all your medications with you the day of surgery. Diabetics should not take any insulin on their day of surgery until they have arrived in the surgicenter and have been instructed to do SO. 3. Other instructions.
